

Effective January 1, 2020 Senate Bill 205 requires a person or entity who conducts business that is a "regulated industry" to obtain certification for an NPDES permit program. Businesses are required to provide a Standard Industrial Classification code (SIC) on an initial City business license application or renewal for verification of the related permits. The goal of the program is to address the health and safety of drinking water sources statewide.

SB 205 does NOT apply to all businesses. Only those businesses with primary Standard Industrial Classification (SIC) codes, that are identified by the State Water Board as requiring enrollment, are affected.

Completion and submission of this form is required with your business license application.
