**PROJECT NAME**: River Springs Charter School – the "Project"

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: A proposal of Keeton Construction for a General Plan Amendment, Change of Zone, and Conditional Use Permit to establish a Grade 6 through 12 education facility within an existing 73,454 square foot building located at 1091 Esplanade Avenue. The 6.41 acre site is located at the northeast corner of Esplanade Avenue and Palm Avenue. 160 parking spaces are provided where 142 spaces are required. To facilitate the Project, the applicant is requesting a General Plan Amendment (GPA 18-1) from Industrial to Business Park; Change of Zone (CZ 18-1) from Light Industrial to Business Park; and Conditional Use Permit CUP (18-1) for an education facility.

**PROJECT LOCATION**: The project is located at 1091 Esplanade Avenue, east of Palm Avenue. (See Aerial Map). The project site located within an unsectioned portion of Range 4 South, Township 1 West, and is identified as Assessor Parcel Numbers 433-291-045 to 047, and 433-291-034.
