





## Streets Division

- Focused pothole repairs on several major street corridors including:
  - State Street from 7<sup>th</sup> Street to Quandt Ranch Road
  - Ramona Expressway from Esplanade Avenue to Warren Road
  - Warren Road from Ramona Expressway to Esplanade Avenue
  - Ramona Blvd from San Jacinto Avenue to Sanderson Avenue
  - Sanderson Avenue from Esplanade Avenue to Ramona Expressway

## Storm Water Division

- In the past 30 days, crews continued jetting residential catch basins & intersections.
- Tested and serviced 20 electrical panels, 42 pumps and approximately 80 electric float switches
- Cleaned and cleared over 30
  retention basins








## Parks Division

## Water Division

• In the past month, the Water Division repaired 25 meters, completed 3,491 meter readings and distributed 418 door hangers. In addition, the Water Division responded to 53 Dig Alert requests.

## Waste Water Division

• The Waste Water Division cleaned approximately 7 miles of sewer lines using high pressure water jetting and videoed inspected another 2,700 feet of sewer lines.
