

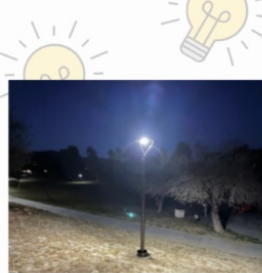


Basin Light Pilot Program: Basin #7

Let there be light. **The Basin Light Pilot Program**



Recently the City of San Jacinto initiated the Basin Light Pilot Program. The pilot program's purpose is to retrofit the lights in the Rancho San Jacinto basin and channel areas. Currently, 10 basins and 3 channels of LLPD1 North, Center, and South contain lights that have not worked in over 10 years. Some lights will also be repositioned for better light coverage.







The installation at Basin 7 (Villines Ave. and Washington Ave.) is the first phase and is now complete. The completed installation has received positive feedback from the residents in the area. The solar lights only require 6-7 hours of direct sunlight for a full charge and will shine for 10-12 hours on that full charge.

GRANT APPLICATION FOR STREET OUTREACH:

The City of San Jacinto's HARP program has applied for a grant through the Riverside County Housing, Homelessness

Prevention & Workforce Solutions (HHPWS) Department Round 2 of the Emergency Solutions Grant- CARES Act Funding (ESG-CV2), with a focus to fund street outreach and bridge housing programs.

Street outreach would be focused on those affected by homelessness, or who are at risk of becoming homeless. The City of San Jacinto would partner with a non-profit organization that specialized in street outreach. Cities generally work together with non-profits to bring services such as street outreach. Partnerships like these help facilitate providing services that will result in the reduction of street-level homelessness through the provision of street outreach, case management, housing navigation, bridge-housing, and assisting with reunifications with family. 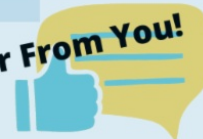
