## San Jacinto City Council Approves Subdivision Improvement **Agreement with Lennar Homes for 77 Lots**

On Tuesday, August 1, 2017, the City of San Jacinto City Council approved a subdivision improvement agreement and welcomed Lennar Homes of California to San Jacinto to build out 77 existing residential lots.

"San Jacinto is continuing to show a strong economic outlook over the next several years. Residential and retail developers are focusing in on our message and outreach and assisting to create a renaissance in this 125 year old start up City", said City Manager Rob Johnson.

Lennar Homes of California has chosen to invest in San Jacinto by acquiring and building 77 new homes to complete a final tract map at 7th Street and Pine Avenue in San Jacinto. San Jacinto has seen a huge increase in residential permits this year and has outpaced the average of its previous four years by nearly double. The City expects to be near or over the 300 mark for new housing permits this year. As of mid-July, 118 permits were issued, which is a stark contrast to the 65 permits it has averaged over the past four years.

San Jacinto has kicked off a rebirth of its economic development program with a fresh perspective on itself by creating a relationship and strong partnership with Retail Strategies, a nationwide company known for assisting cities in identifying and recruiting retail, restaurant and entertainment concepts.

"The partnership with Retail Strategies is already proving that San Jacinto is an attractive housing market, with a growing retail base, and we are so excited to have Lennar Homes developing and offering its brand to those that want to move up and move in to the San Jacinto community," said Johnson.
